

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time: In today's first reading, the Lord speaks through the prophet Isaiah during a time of political upheaval and moral decline. 





FAITH FORMATION




Sunday's Gospel: Matthew 15: 21-28

Here are the reflection questions for this Sunday's Gospel Reflection Questions:

What is faith? In day-to-day life, what do you, or others have faith in? How is having faith in Jesus different from these other things?

The Canaanite women identified Jesus as, "Son of David!" She also was asking for pity, she was humble, yet Jesus kept pushing back. Jesus would not give her what she was asking for in the beginning of their meeting. Why? What was Jesus seeking? How did it make a difference in the Canaanite woman's life? How does it make a difference in your life?



Is it possible to carry out good conversations with people with whom I disagree? As incivility, bullying, and mean-spirited communication have risen to new heights in our society, people of good faith wonder how we might change this tide of disrespect. Written for small-group discussion as well as personal reflection, 7 Steps to better conversations offers a fresh approach to communicating in our most difficult relationships, whether online or in

person.

Building upon the teachings of Pope Francis, Lorene Duquin explores several ways in which we might come together to talk through our differences, challenges, and disagreements with renewed kindness, honesty, and respect. Pop Francis reminds us that the "world will recognize the disciples of Jesus by the way they love one another." Christian love is at the heart of better communication through the shared belief that we are all sons and daughters of a loving God.

Joan Williamson will be facilitating group discussion using this book, We will meet for four weeks with a Tuesday evening group (7-8:30 pm), and a Wednesday morning (10-11:30 am) group
