

St. John the Baptist Website Privacy Policy

What information do we collect? The St. John the Baptist website does not collect personal user information except when provided on a voluntary basis, such as by filling out an online contact form. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable like your name, address, email address, or phone number, and that is not otherwise publicly available.

- Personal information may be gathered when voluntarily given from an email request for information or services from the archdiocese or an online enquiry form. We do not request financial information on this site, but rather direct you to Faith Direct to complete any registration calling for payment.
- Personal information is gathered when processing an online registration or pledge
- Behavioral information may be gathered through the use of cookies by our host server, Dreamhost. Cookies are simple text files stored on the user's computer. They are not executable files and are not viruses.

What we use your information for?

- To respond to your enquiries and requests
- To process your registration or pledge
- To improve the user experience on our website

Information sharing and disclosure

- Personally identifiable information on individual users will not be sold or otherwise transferred to unaffiliated third parties without the approval of the user at the time of collection.
- No credit card information is stored by the Archdiocese during the processing of transactions through a third party financial institution on secured servers.
- No personal information is gathered through the use of cookies. Analysis of user behavior may be used to measure interest in and use of the various web pages in order to deliver and improve site content.
