



What Are You Doing for Lent?

The three traditional practices of Lent are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. Many of us can remember as a child being taught to choose something to "give up" for Lent. What is more important than what we "give up" is why we give something up: why we fast, why we pray, why we give alms. The aim of these practices is our continuing conversion to Christ, our growth in knowledge of Him, and doing His will.

If you would like to do a little more prayer this Lent, consider praying the Liturgy of the Hours, which is done on Mondays and Tuesdays at 9:00 am. Weekday Mass is celebrated on Wednesdays and Fridays at 9:00 am and on Thursdays at 6:30 pm. Stations of the Cross are prayed on Fridays at 7:00 pm. Get started with Lent at our Parish Retreat on Saturday, February 17 starting at 9:00 am.

Fasting can be from certain foods. It can also be from things that inhibit your ongoing conversion to Christ. Maybe you can consider fasting from screen time. Work at overcoming a fault, a bad habit or particular vice with which you struggle. Replace the bad action with its opposite good action.

Almsgiving incudes your charitable giving to the church and to the needy. It could also include an increased generosity of compliments, "thank-yous," and words of encouragement. Your almsgiving could include a little extra help offered to a friend or family member.

A great opportunity for Lent is to participate in a small *Faith Sharing Group*. Join members of our parish for a weekly meeting to break open the scriptures, dialogue, and pray together during Lent. This will be a five-week journey with the options of an in-person group on Tuesday or Wednesday evenings or Zoom meetings on Thursday mornings. Let your Lent lead you closer to Christ. Pray, fast, and give alms.

Did you know that the earliest date Ash Wednesday can fall on is February 4? The last time it fell on this date was in 1818. The next one will occur in 2285.

**Steffi Daniel** did a wonderful drawing of Ash Wednesday on the front of this bulletin. Here is how she describes Ash Wednesday:

"This drawing talks about Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday is the beginning of the Lent season. On Ash Wednesday we go for mass and the priest marks the sign of the cross with Ash on our forehead. We do this so that we remember to ask sorry for our sins, pray, and help other people in need. The Ash reminds us that we are made by God and we belong to him."

#### 40 Days, 40 Ways

St. John the Baptist's Creation Care Team will be sharing some ideas each week through Lent from the Franciscan Action Organization, "40 Days; 40 Ways Guide." The ideas are designed to provide an alternative or enrichment to your Lenten observations with creation-centered activities. We hope you will consider challenging yourself with some creative action this Lent.



Start a Nature Journal: For many people, "nature" has become a place to hurry through as we are going somewhere else. Unfortunately, in regard to environmental health, this is a problem, for we won't be moved to fight for a world that we hardly know. One remedy for our alienation may be to spend attentive time outdoors on a regular basis (the word *journal* means "daily"). What is going on? What are we seeing? Smelling? Hearing? The rich and myriad details of the natural world, often passing under our radar, rise to our attention when we need to record them. The marvel is that waking up to the world around us helps us to "wake up" to our own sense of being part of God's miraculous creation!

Next week, the team will share another idea.

#### We Need Your Help Planting Trees!

It's time for the forest on our church grounds to progress from deciduous Cottonwoods and Alders into mature evergreens of native Douglas Fir, Western Red Cedar, Sitka Spruce, and Western Hemlock. Their thick year-round cover will help shade out the destructive ivy that's invading the forest.

Join us in planting a mixture of 130 native conifer seedlings on **Saturday**, **March 2**, **from 10 am to Noon**.

Middle and high school students as well as adults are invited, but middle schoolers must be accompanied by parent/guardian. Community Service Credit is available for high school students.

We recommend wearing long pants, long sleeve shirts, and garden gloves. Bring rain gear in case it rains. Please bring a shovel, Pulaski, or hand clippers if you have them.


This event is planned for **Friday**, **February 23**, **2024 from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm**. There will be snacks, art projects, and a movie provided.
