

# Rice Bowl Awards Grant to Garden of Good Shepherd

The Garden of the Good Shepherd received a \$1,000.00 Rice Bowl Grant, thanks to the Archdiocese of Seattle and to the wonderful parishioners of St. John the Baptist Parish who made generous contributions to the Rice Bowl Lenten program.

These grants are used exclusively for hunger alleviation programs. Since 2015, the *Garden of the Good Shepherd* has been growing, harvesting, and donating produce to the *Covington Storehouse*, our local food bank. They donated a total of approximately 1700 pounds in 2023. With the blessings of this grant money, we have been able to install two 4x8 raised garden beds, receive 6 yards of compost, purchase starter plants, and have some money for the remainder of the season.
