

# **CYO Soccer at St. Anthony**




Partner with St. Anthony for youth sports. CYO soccer and cross country registration is now open. To register, visit us at reg.sportspilot.com/106634/login.

Distances are 0.4 miles for grades K-2, 0.6 miles for 3rd graders, 1 mile for grades 4-5, 1.35 miles for grades 6-7, and 1.5 miles for 8th graders.
