Kicking Off the Season of Creation



The Season of Creation is the annual Christian celebration to pray and respond together to the cry of Creation. The ecumenical family around the world unites to listen and care for our common home. The Celebration begins September 1 with

The Feast of Creation, also known as Creation Day or World Day of Prayer for Creation. It is the celebration that inspires and nourishes the larger Season of Creation that flows from it. Inspired by a rich tradition of the Orthodox Church, it was later embraced by the World Council of Churches in 2008 and the Catholic Church in 2015. The season ends on October 4 with the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology and beloved by many Christian denominations.

This year September 1 falls on a Sunday, so it is a very special occasion. Sunday has a dual symbolism: the day when God began the first day of His creative act (Genesis 1), and *The Day of the Resurrection* (St. Justin Martyr, *First Apology*, Chapter 67; St. Gregory the Great, *Primo die quo Trinitas*, laudatosimovement.org/news/why-a-feast-of-creation-on-september-1/)

The 2024 theme for *Season of Creation* is to "Hope and Act with Creation."

In the letter of Paul the apostle to the Romans, the biblical image pictures the earth as a mother, groaning as in childbirth (Romans 8:22). Francis of Assisi understood this when he referred to the earth as our sister and our mother in his *Canticle of Creatures*. The times we live in today show that we are not relating to the earth as a gift from our Creator but rather as a resource to be used.

And yet, there is hope and the expectation for a better future. To hope in a biblical context does not mean to stand still and quiet; but rather groaning, crying, and actively striving for new life amidst the struggles. Just as in childbirth, we go through a period of intense pain, but new life springs forth!






