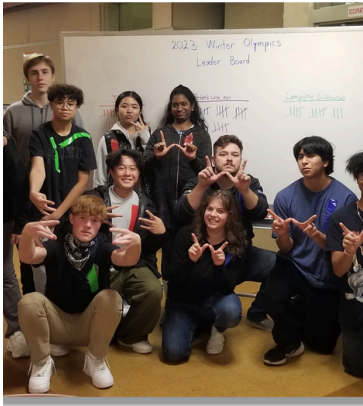

At least 572 parishioner families gave of their time and talent, including 27 catechists, and 371 pledged their treasure.

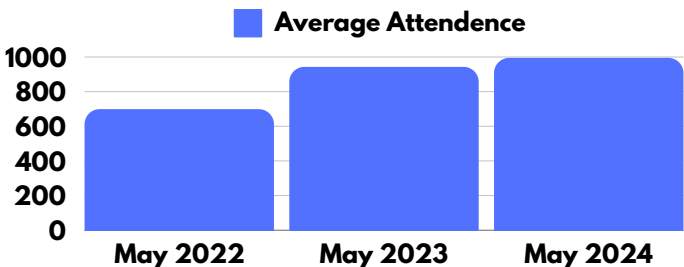
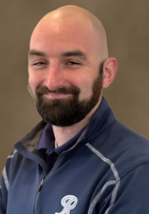


St. John the Baptist has 1335 households. We celebrated

Average weekend Mass attendance in May increased by 5.5% over last year.

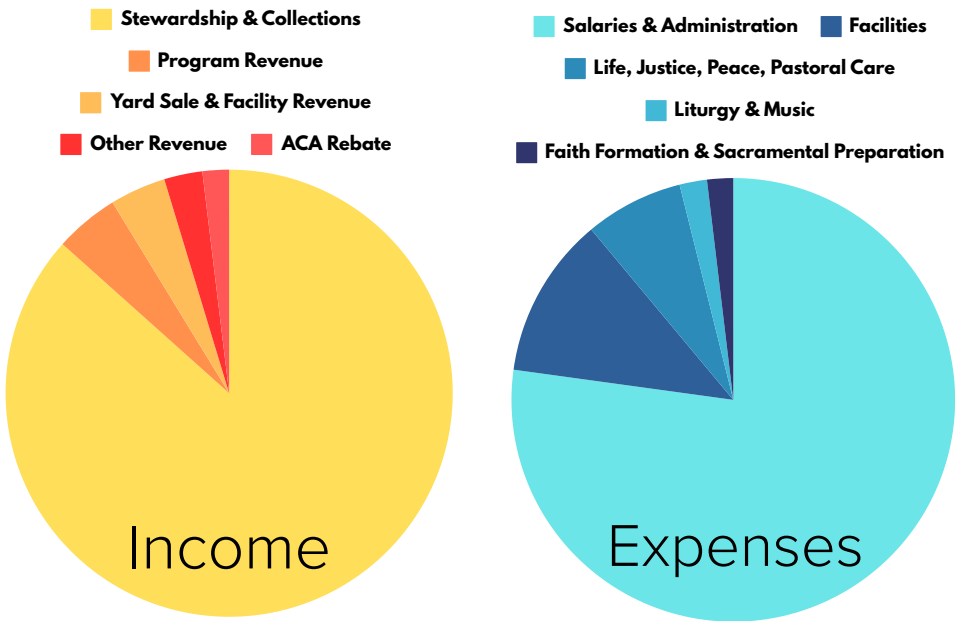
