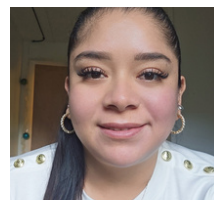
In July we celebrated one year as a parish family with Holy Spirit with a joint procession to Vietnamese Martyrs.

St. John the Baptist has **1190** registered households.

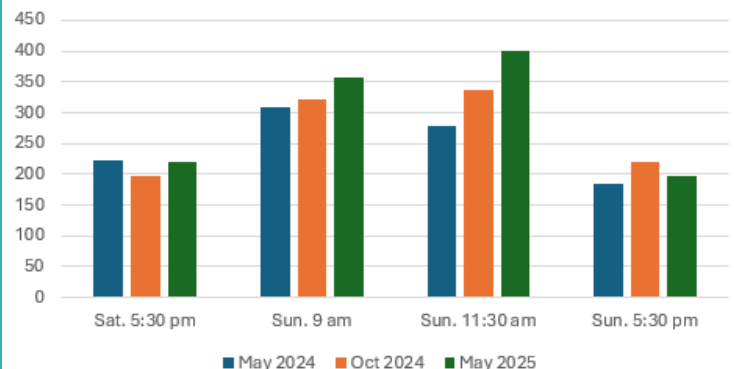
