## Celebrating Our Lady of Guadalupe

Joyful celebrations honored Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 11 - 12, 2025, with traditional dancers in colorful regalia, shared food, and reverent worship at both parishes. Although the long procession was canceled due to inclement weather, a shorter procession took place from Kent Plaza to Holy Spirit Parish. The feast commemorates the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Juan Diego in 1531; yet, as Fr. Carlos wrote, "Guadalupe is not only history. She is a living Gospel, still revealing what we need to see."

From the desk of Stewardship and Outreach: The Knights of Columbus recognized a need and stepped in to direct traffic to available spots in our lot and to our overflow parking at Covington Elementary. There were 752 people participating in the Children's Christmas Eve Mass this year, 527 at the 7 pm Mass, and 367 at the 10 pm Mass. There were 542 at the Christmas Day Mass, a 26% increase over last year. Thank you **Mark, Bailey, Gilbert, and Jose!**

And thanks to all who donated items and gifts to our **Giving Tree!** Like our Thanksgiving Meal program, Giving Tree allows us to invite those experiencing poverty to participate in our cultural tradition of gift giving on Christmas Day. Your generosity sends a message of hope to all children.

He rose, took the child and his mother, and went to the land of Israel. (Mt 2:21)


