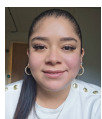

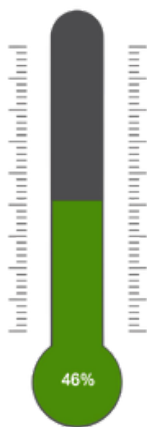

A More Caring Communion Experience



Following this weekend's Liturgical Minister Training sessions, we will be implementing an important change in the way Holy Communion is distributed within our congregation.

After the Eucharistic Ministers receive their vessels, they will first proceed to the back of the sanctuary to serve parishioners who may have difficulty walking to the altar to receive Communion. Once these parishioners have been served, the ministers will return to the front of the church and begin distributing Communion to the general congregation.

While this change may add a few extra minutes before the general congregation receives Communion, we sincerely appreciate your patience, kindness, and understanding as we work to better accommodate parishioners with mobility challenges.

A note for the ministers serving at the Sunday 5:30 p.m. Mass: the Precious Blood of Christ will continue to be distributed by two ministers, while the other Masses are currently served by four. We are grateful for your faithful service and understand that this difference may present some challenges. We are sincerely hopeful that more parishioners will feel called to serve as Eucharistic Ministers, so that in time we may expand this ministry more fully and ensure all who wish to receive the Precious Blood of Christ are able to do so.

Wrapping Up the Fiscal Year Together

You Don't Have to Grieve Alone

A 9-week Grief Support Program is being offered by Family 30's Grief Ministry. *Walking Through Grief* is an educational and inspirational program that offers support, comfort, and hope to those experiencing the loss of a loved one. This program is offered free of charge.

June 3, 2026 - July 29, 2026
7:00 pm to 8:30 pm each Wednesday evening
Meetings are online via Zoom

Over nine weekly sessions, participants will find support, understanding, and hope while learning about the journey through grief. Each session features professionally produced videos with grief experts and personal stories from individuals who share their own experiences of loss and healing. Weekly sessions include a focused topic, gentle group discussion, and simple workbook reflections to continue between meetings. Participants will receive a workbook, along with helpful tools, handouts, and articles to support them along the way.

Backpack Buddies: Keep It Coming



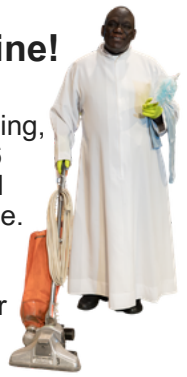
