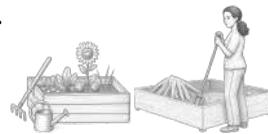
Come Dig in the Dirt!

Lost and found items:

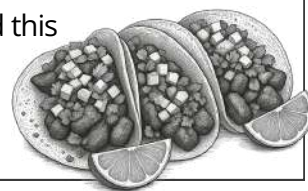
- A bag of letters from 1958-1960 was found among the donations for the garage sale.
