Receiving Communion in Your Seat

All who are prepared to receive the Eucharist are welcome to do so. If you are unable to approach to receive Communion—whether due to age, mobility, illness, or any other reason—we want to ensure that you do not miss out. Our Eucharistic ministers are able to bring you Communion wherever you are seated.



At Holy Spirit:

Those who need to receive Communion while seated are welcome to sit in the pews reserved for those with mobility difficulties. **Before Mass**, tell an usher where you will be sitting; they will let the Eucharistic ministers know to come to you.

In San Juan Bautista:

If you would like Communion brought to your seat, please ask one of our hospitality ministers for a yellow chair designator as you enter the church. Place the small flag on the aisle side of your chair so our Eucharistic minister can easily see it. Please sit as close to the aisle as possible to help prevent spills. Let a hospitality minister know where you will be sitting before Mass begins. If we happen to miss you, simply ask a family member or friend to let the Eucharistic minister know when you will be receiving Communion, and we will bring it to you immediately.

Correction - Donate Leftover Yarn

Bring your leftover yarn on weekends of 7/19 (SJ only) and 7/25 (both parishes). The yarn collected will be donated to knitters and crocheters who donate their cozy items to local organizations. This includes the Knights of Columbus Coats for Kids program and the Yarning for Communities group at the Kent Senior Center.



There will be a collection box in the narthex of both parishes.

Step into Fellowship

The weekly walking group at St. John the Baptist is moving to 9:45 am on Tuesday mornings, following the 9 am Mass.

To join, gather outside the Parish Office lobby for a 30-minute walk on our easy-to-moderate paved route. Strollers, pups, and friends welcome. Prefer a gentler pace? Join our "inside loop crew" on the parish grounds instead. No sign-up needed—just come dressed for the weather. If it's rainy, we walk indoors.

Prayer Time for Men

The community of St. Joseph invites all men to pray the rosary every Wednesday. Open to all men, not just those consecrated to St. Joseph.

Couldn't you stay with me for an hour?

Eucharistic Adoration is a sacred time of silent prayer and meditation before Jesus, present in the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration takes place in both parishes on the first Friday of each month.

The Blessed Sacrament should never be left completely unattended. Volunteer lists are available at St. Anthony's Chapel and in the nave of St. John the Baptist the week before.

Recibiendo la Comunión en Su Asiento

Todos los que están preparados para recibir la Eucaristía son bienvenidos a hacerlo. Si no puede acercarse a recibir la comunión—ya sea por edad, movilidad, enfermedad o cualquier otra razón—queremos asegurarnos de que no se quede sin ella. Nuestros ministros eucarísticos están aquí para traerle la comunión dondequiera que esté sentado.



En la Parroquia del Espíritu Santo:

Aquellos que necesiten recibir la Comunión mientras están sentados son bienvenidos a sentarse en los bancos reservados para personas con dificultades de movilidad. Antes de la Misa, informa a un acomodador dónde estarás sentado; él informará a los ministros de la Eucaristía para que te lleven la Comunión.

En San Juan Bautista:

Si necesita que le traigan la comunión a su asiento, pida a uno de nuestros ministros de hospitalidad un designador de silla amarilla al entrar a la iglesia. Coloque la pequeña bandera en el lado del pasillo de su silla para que nuestro ministro eucarístico pueda verla fácilmente. Por favor, siéntese lo más cerca posible del pasillo para ayudar a prevenir derrames. Avísele a un ministro de hospitalidad dónde estará antes de que comience la Misa. Si por alguna razón lo pasamos por alto, simplemente pídale a un miembro de la familia o amigo que le avise al ministro eucarístico cuando reciba la comunión, y le traeremos la comunión de inmediato.
